

## **Medicaid Coverage of COVID-19 Testing, Vaccine Administration, and Treatment for Uninsured Individuals**

New Hampshire residents who are uninsured or who have limited health insurance coverage that does not cover COVID testing, vaccine administration and/or treatment may be eligible for the Medicaid COVID-19 Group coverage. Under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the Medicaid COVID-19 Testing Group, renamed the Medicaid COVID-19 Group, now covers COVID-19 vaccine administration and certain treatment services in addition to coverage for testing. The expanded coverage includes hospitalizations, emergency room visits, urgent care clinic visits, telemedicine visits, and office visits for the treatment of COVID-19. The vaccine administration for the COVID-19 Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, and Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) first, second, third and booster vaccine doses are also covered. Individuals who are uninsured or who have limited health insurance coverage may be eligible for this option, and should visit [NH EASY - Gateway to Services](#) to apply by scrolling to the “COVID-19 Group” button and clicking on the link.
