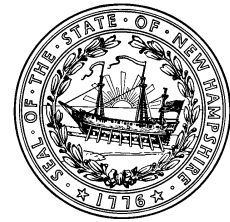

NH DHHS COVID-19 Update April 28, 2022

Concord, NH – The New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has issued the following update on the new coronavirus, COVID-19.

On Thursday, April 28, 2022, DHHS announced 378 new positive test results for COVID-19 for Wednesday, April 27. Today's results include 282 people who tested positive by PCR test and 96 who tested positive by antigen test. DHHS also announced an additional 21 new cases from Tuesday, April 26 (16 by PCR and 5 by antigen test) for a new total of 535. Test results for previous days are still being processed and updated case counts for prior days will be reflected on the [COVID-19 interactive dashboard](#). There are now 2,921 current COVID-19 cases diagnosed in New Hampshire.

Several cases are still under investigation. Additional information from ongoing investigations will be incorporated into future COVID-19 updates. Of those with complete information, there are forty-five individuals under the age of 18 and the rest are adults with 56% being female and 44% being male. The new cases reside in Hillsborough County other than Manchester and Nashua (73), Rockingham (68), Strafford (56), Merrimack (31), Grafton (29), Cheshire (20), Carroll (14), Belknap (13), Sullivan (13), and Coos (10) counties, and in the cities of Nashua (30) and Manchester (29). The county of residence is being determined for thirteen new cases.

DHHS has also announced one additional death related to COVID-19. We offer our sympathies to the family and friends.

- 1 female resident of Grafton County, fewer than 60 years of age

There are currently 22 hospitalized patients being treated for COVID-19. In New Hampshire, since the start of the pandemic, there have been a total of 309,552 cases of COVID-19 diagnosed.
